

## FINAL PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has received the subgrant application for Jackson County Pascagoula beach renourishment due to damages from Hurricane Zeta (DR-4576-MS PW-00232). Pursuant to Executive Order 11988 and 44 CFR Part 9.12, final notice is hereby given of FEMA's intent to provide funding for this project under the Public Assistance (PA) Program.

An initial disaster-wide Public Notice was published January 7, 2021 for Hurricane Zeta. Comments and other information received were fully evaluated by FEMA along with evaluation of social, economic, environmental, and safety considerations. This notice serves as a project-specific final notice for FEMA's funding action located within the floodplain.

Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements and conditions.

- Floodplain:** The project is located in a VE Zone also known as a coastal high hazard area, per Jackson County FIRM Panel #28059C0287G, 28059C0289G, dated 3/16/2009.
- Proposed Work and Purpose:** The county proposes to replace 2,444 CY of sand on Ocean Spring Front Beach along 5,531 LF to restore the beach to pre-disaster condition. Fill will be obtained from a commercial source.
- Project Alternatives:** The alternative that has been considered is the no action alternative. This alternative is not feasible due to potential adverse social and economic impacts on the community if the shoreline is not restored. Alternate locations were not considered as the beach is functionally dependent upon its location within the floodplain. The beach provides open space use of the floodplain and recreational value for the community.
- Comments:** This will serve as the final public notice regarding the above-described action funded by the FEMA PA program.
